## COVID-19 Travel Information:

### **Travel to Saudi Arabia**

There are restrictions on the categories of passengers who can enter Saudi Arabia at this time. Please check the requirements before you travel. If you are travelling to Saudi Arabia, you must take a COVID-19 PCR test before departure.

### **COVID-19 testing requirements**

All non-Saudi nationals, except children 8 years old and below, must present a negative COVID-19 PCR test result issued by an accredited laboratory. The test must be done not later than 72 hours before the scheduled departure for the Kingdom.

### **General provisions**

- All non-vaccinated international travellers arriving in Saudi Arabia must complete institutional quarantine starting from the time of arrival at the institutional quarantine facilities. Travellers from South Africa will, in addition to the above, be required to fulfil a mandatory 2-week quarantine in a “green” zone country before entering the quarantine facility in Saudi Arabia.
- The duration of the institutional quarantine for all travellers arriving in Saudi Arabia, is for a period of 7 days and will include 2 COVID-19 PCR tests.
- Quarantine shall be in the city of arrival.
- All passengers must carry a valid passport (including GCC citizens).



### **Travel to Bahrain**

From 25 June 2021, 23:59hrs (Bahrain time), passengers eligible for entry to the Kingdom of Bahrain are required to present a negative COVID-19 PCR test certificate featuring a QR code. The test needs to be conducted not more than 72 hours before departure.

### **Travel to Oman**

If you are travelling to Oman, you will be required to take a COVID-19 PCR test and undergo institutional quarantine on arrival.

### **Travel to Sudan**

If you're travelling to Sudan, you'll need to take a COVID-19 PCR test before departure and present a printed certificate at check-in.
